




WHERE WE ARE

Located in northern Vietnam, Mai Chau is an alluring valley in the Hoa Binh Province. Not far from Hanoi, the area is hemmed in by hills, disconnected from the chaos of the city. Our Ecolodge is hidden deep in the valley, atop a private hill in Na Phon Village.

ACCOMMODATION

These living spaces are assembled entirely from locally sourced, natural materials. Unique elements include thatched roofs, bamboo and wooden interiors, and private outdoor garden shower terraces. Every bungalow was meticulously designed to embody the spirit of a local stilt house, traditional to ethnic Thai culture. The absence of television and other entertainment keeps our lodge true to its purpose — a place to be with nature.




SUPERIOR ROOM

GREEN APPROACH: Minimize Our Ecological Footprint


- Renewable Energy: Solar energy powers all outdoor lighting and the spa.
- Water Resources: Water supplies are derived from limestone deposits only a 1,000 meters away.
- Wastewater Treatment: Wastewater undergoes several steps of refinement before being released.
- Garbage Classification: Biodegradable and nonbiodegradable trash are separated before disposal.
- Transportation: Bicycles allow for eco-friendly transport around the area.
- Days" encourage our employees, and visitors, to participate in activities such as litter removal or tree planting.






CULTURAL APPROACH
